Mary was a long-standing helper to the parish and was awarded the Champion Medal a couple of years ago in recognition of her long service.

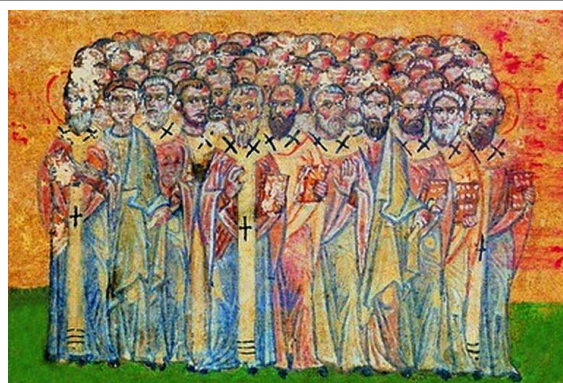
Her funeral will take place on Thursday 31st July (the feast of St Ignatius) in St Peter's Church.
