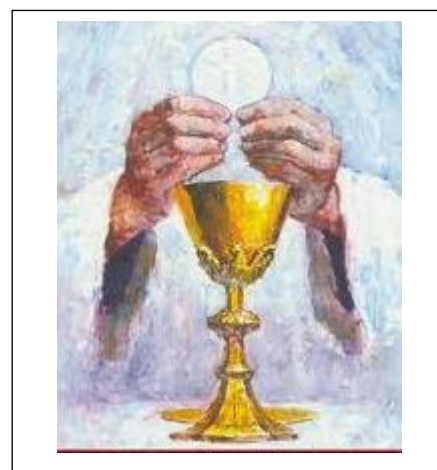

Diocesan Synod

Bishop John Arnold has convoked a diocesan synod. It will follow the pattern of the Universal Synod last year. We will need sharing groups to consider the questions. We will also need to select two representatives to attend the synod itself in person. Sharing groups will meet in December and the first Synod Assembly is planned for next year.

Our deanery will be gathering for an evening of Prayer at St Joseph's, Blackburn, on Tuesday 18th July from 6.30pm.

Two parishioners have agreed to represent the Parish at the Synod meetings. They will be introduced at the AGM today.
