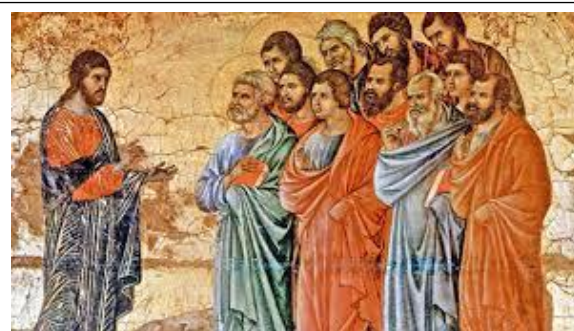

St Aloysius is the original patron of Stonyhurst College when it moved here in 1973. He was a young man of a wealthy family. His father wanted him to be a soldier, but he wanted to be a Jesuit. He died during his studies when he went to the assistance of plague victims in Rome. His feast day is 21<sup>st</sup> June, but the college will celebrate it next Wednesday.
