Pope Leo to the youth of the world

Pope Leo addressed the youth gathered in Rome for World Youth Day on 3rd August. He spoke in English, Italian and Spanish. These are some extracts from his holily:

"We are closer than ever to young people who suffer the most serious evils, which are caused by other human beings."

"We are with the young people of Gaza. We are with the young people of Ukraine, with those of every land bloodied by war."

"My young brothers and sisters, you are the sign that a different world is possible. A world of fraternity and friendship, where conflicts are not resolved with weapons, but with dialogue." "Aspire to great things, to holiness, wherever you are,".

"Do not settle for less. You will then see the light of the Gospel growing every day, in you and around you."

More than one million young people gathered in Rome to celebrate with the Holy Father, from an estimated 150 different countries. They camped out where they could and many lost their voices through singing! All enjoyed a tremendous atmosphere.

Pope Leo announced that the next World Youth Day will be, in Seoul, South Korea from 3rd to -8th August 2027.

The one million youth are part of the estimated 32 million people who will visit Rome during this Jubilee year.
