## **St Agnes**

Agnes of Rome lived at the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Century. She was persecuted for being a Christian and more specifically, for refusing to marry at the age of 13. She is the patron saint of young girls on account of her defense of her virginity. In art she is often depicted with a lamb (her name, “Agnes” means “lamb” in Latin), but also because for her, Jesus was the Lamb of God.
